The Hollidaysburg Area Public Library's Summer Reading Program is a family read-to-me program. Family members read library books to their preschool child during each week of the program, recording the book titles/number of minutes read on a reading log provided by the Library. A small participation prize is awarded each week after the book log is checked by Library staff. Each week has a different participation prize.

Option One: Individual Check-In. During each week of the program, you choose from the days and times available, and visit the library. You do not have to come at the same time or same day each week. Check in takes only a short time; just long enough to return your finished books, choose/check out your new ones, and receive your participation prize for that week.
