Please choose one from the options below: Option One: Individual Check-In (not a group time but on your own; lets you have scheduling flexibility) This option is not a story and craft time but instead you visit the library to "check in" with your book log and receive your participation prize each week of the program, choosing from the Option One times shown on the bottom half of this page. You are always welcome to come to any/all special guest programs in addition to this option. Option Two: Group Check-In: Stories and Craft. We hold a short group time, usually including stories and a craft or other activity. Sometimes, instead of group time, we hold a special guest program. After group time or program time, we check book logs, get the weekly participation prize, and check out fresh books to read for next time! (choose and circle one time only): Tuesdays at 6:00pm Wednesdays at 1pm Thursdays at 1pm or 3pm (Please let us know if there are any weeks you cannot attend. Students who have finished Kindergarten through Fourth Grade: June 19 through August 12 The Hollidaysburg Area Public Library's Summer Reading Program is an independent reading program with the participants reading two library books at their reading level per week. Book categories are chosen randomly by rolling dice and moving on a game board. Participants write their book titles on a book log provided by the Library. A small participation prize is awarded each week after the book log is checked by Library staff. Each week has a different participation prize. Option One: Individual Check-In. During each week of the program, you choose among the days and times available, and check in on your own. You do not have to arrive at the same time or same day each week; this gives you scheduling flexibility. Check in takes only a short time; just long enough to return two finished books, use the game board to select two new ones, and receive your participation prize for that week.

Tuesdays at 6:00pm (meets June 20 and 27, (CLOSED July 4)\*, July 11, 18 and 25, August 1 and 8)

Wednesdays at 1pm (meets June 21 and 28, July 5, 12, 19, 26, August 2 and 9)

Thursdays at 1pm or 3pm (meets June 22 and 29, July 6, 13, 20 and 27, August 3 and 10)

\*The Library is closed Tuesday July 4 for the Independence Day holiday. If you are signed up for group check-in Tuesdays at 6pm, you are welcome to choose another check-in time for the week of July 4 or to do individual check-in—your choice.
